Some specific out-workings include preparing communion, assisting at baptisms, new mother support, staff support, food drives, home/hospital visits, flowers and gifts, blood drives, baby and wedding showers, meals, and Christmas baskets for shut-ins.

We invite you to read through the list below to see if anything resonates with your skill set and passion. You can make this a one-time service opportunity, or join our team!

- Pray for our ministry as we serve our West Hills family and community!
- Prepare communion with another WH Servant once per month
- Assist at baptisms
- Help with baby/ bridal showers
- Make baked goods for various occasions (cookies, cakes, cupcakes, etc)
- Prepare meals as needed for love gifts or other needed occasion
- Visit the sick in the hospital or at home
- Make or write cards for those needing encouragement
- Provide baby blankets for WHCC newborns
- Send birthday cards to WHCC staff members
- Bake cookies and help prepare cookie trays during the Christmas season
- Publicize and coordinate the annual blood drive
- Show hospitality and encouragement to those giving blood during the blood drive
- Assist in serving food at various church wide events
- Donate food to the WHCC food pantry
- Assist with dispersement of food on a Saturday morning or Sunday between services (once per month)
- Help set up/ break down tables and chairs for various events.
